Nonprofit Launches Tour Program

Events focus on the organization's mission and Denver-area homelessness

Denver – March 4, 2015 – [Family Promise of Greater Denver](#) is beginning to offer tours of its Day Site, providing community members with an opportunity to learn more about its emergency program for homeless families.

Family Promise has provided shelter, meals and supportive services to more than 1,000 Denver-area families over the last 18 years. At night, families stay at [area congregations](#), and during the day, they're often at the nonprofit's [Day Site](#) – meeting with case managers and working on goals such as employment, housing and education in the site's computer lab.

"The Day Site is considered a safe space. Families experiencing homelessness are often battling so many uncertainties, but this location offers them a stable environment to focus on a brighter future," said Jolynn Snyder, executive director at Family Promise. "The Day Site even has a playroom, kitchen and big backyard to support program guests. We are here to help them with employment, housing, financial stability and other focuses – this space is a crucial component to [our mission](#)."

Day Site tours take attendees through the facility, discussing the population served, the reasons for homelessness, the services Family Promise offers, and how to get involved with the organization.
